

CAREERS WEBSITE... MYFUTURE


The careers website, myfuture, <u>myfuture - Australia's National Career Information Service | myfuture</u> is funded by the Government and is a free resource for all Australians, particularly designed for students. It provides tools and resources to support career decision making.

Early in the career investigation process, it is helpful to think of "direction setting" rather than final "decision making"... e.g. rather than thinking of a particular job you want, perhaps think of a vocational area that you'd like to work in e.g. think of working in the Health industry rather than thinking only specifically of being a doctor. When you have more information, you may be in a better position to think of specific careers within that industry.

The myfuture software provides information about careers e.g. about types of occupations and types of industries. It has career stories that help you see the pathways various people have taken in reaching their career. It has career bullseye charts that give you an idea of careers that might link to subjects you like at school - see the next page. There is information about courses of study that may be helpful for you. Additionally, there is a career profile activity where you answer some 'fun' questions and the software suggests various occupations that may be of interest to you.
