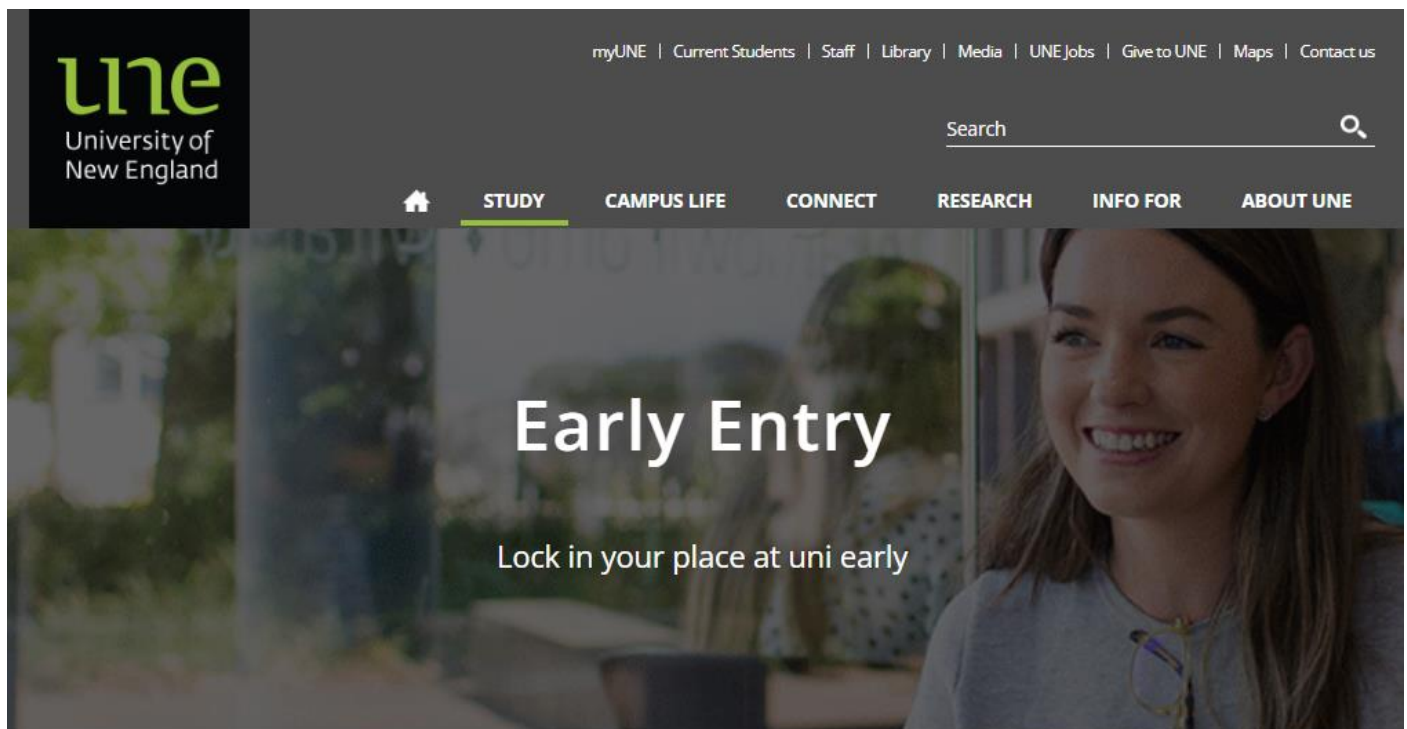

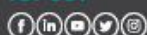

- The Nursing School Based Trainee (SBT) program provides young people with invaluable paid nursing work experience in a local public hospital/facility while completing the Certificate III Health Services Assistance. If you have an interest in becoming a nurse, or you just love helping others, this may be a great opportunity for you! You will continue your schooling, while working a day per week and gaining first-hand experience, with the traineeship also contributing to your final ATAR.
- It's a great way of forging a career in nursing - you may decide to go on and become an Assistant in Nursing (AIN) as all successfully completed trainees able to become a casual AIN upon completion. Or you may use your Certificate III as a pathway into the Diploma of Nursing (Enrolled Nursing) or even an undergraduate degree at university (Registered Nursing).
