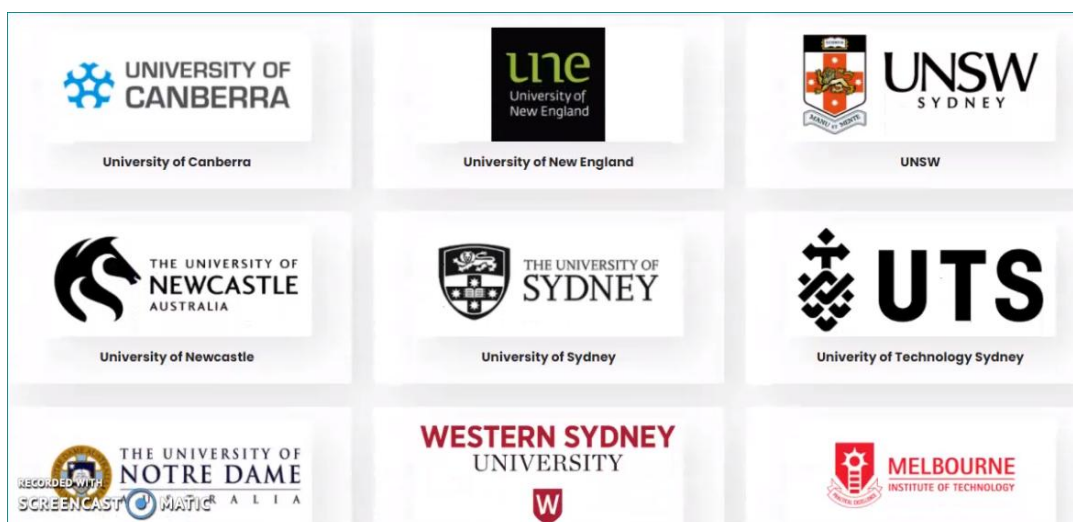

JOB JUMP SOFTWARE – CAREERS INFORMATION

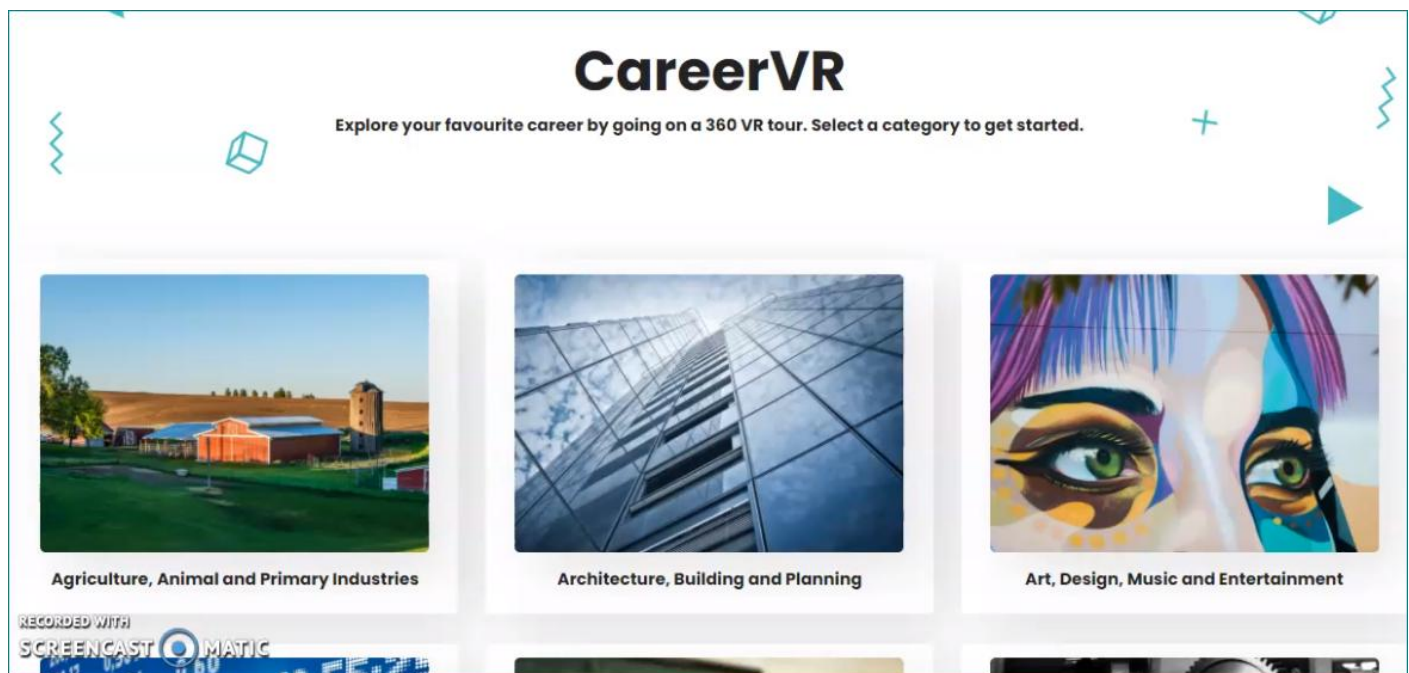



We would like you to register on JobJump so you will receive News on the Careers you like sent to your home email address. It may only take one bit of news to unlock and inspire you towards your future career. Plus you will be able to use all parts of the JobJump website to help plan and achieve your Career dreams. It is there to help through to an extra year after your Year 12.

To register with JobJump, go to the front screen of the website at <https://www.jobjump.com.au/> Click on **I'm New**. On the new screen, enter into the first white box the first letters of your school's name and **when the full name appears just below in blue**, click on your blue school name and it will enter automatically into the first white box.

In the second white box, enter your school password which is:

finches

and click Continue. You then need to enter a few details and set your **Personal Password**. (Min 6 characters). So whenever you then come back to Login to JobJump, all you will then need is your email address and Personal Password.

Two things to remember:

1. If you can't find the career from the list offered that suits you, select a career which is in the field you like. For example, you may like the field of Tourism and the idea of having a career in the Tourism industry is not a bad idea. In the listing select 'Travel Agent' because all Tourism careers news will come to you.

EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST NOW OPEN!

Students take part in hands on, non-accredited training. This training allows students to get hands on experience and skills in the Metals industry. The students will learn Auto CAD using 2D CAD Drawings to draw their own fire pit with a customised decal.

Students will gain entry level skills in gas metal arc and manual metal arc (MIG and Stick) welding processes. They will also learn to safely operate an oxy-acetylene plant and practice the capabilities of this process. After students have gained industry experience, they will begin to manufacture their firepits.

This will consist of;

- Cutting the plate parts on the CNC plasma machine,
- Fabricating using measuring and marking out skills
- Welding the firepit
- Reading and interpreting plans
- Measuring and cutting steel sections
- Fabrication and welding the frame
