

UNSW Application Process of 7 Steps for Bachelor of Medical Studies/Doctor of Medicine

To study the Bachelor of Medical Studies/Doctor of Medicine (BMed/MD) at UNSW, you must sit the University Clinical Aptitude Test (UCAT ANZ). You'll also need to apply through UNSW's Medicine Application Portal (MAP) before submitting a UAC application. Additionally, you will need to undertake an interview (if competitive). Offers to study medicine at UNSW are based on your academic performance (ATAR or equivalent), UCAT ANZ result and interview. Upcoming Dates:

- 30 September last day to lodge application with UAC
- 30 September Last day to submit UNSW Medicine application through the Medicine Application Portal
- 1 December Last day to include UNSW BMed/MD as a UAC preference
