Stage 2: Accredited Training and Excursions

Students who wish to continue their interest from attending the Exploration Session will be encouraged to enrol in the accredited training component delivered by Registered Training Organisation The Instruction Company. The unit of competency is the TLIF0020 Safely Access Rail Corridor (SARC) which is a mandatory requirement for receiving the Rail Industry Worker (RIW) card for many rail network providers. Think of it as a White Card for the rail industry

• End of November, TIC Rail, Beresfield. The training and excursions will be a 2day program.

Stage 3: Work Experience

Having attended the Exploration Session and completed the accredited training and connected with employers, students will have a better understanding of careers in the rail industry. Students who have successfully completed Stage 1 and 2 will have the opportunity to undertake a 1-week workexperience opportunity with participating employers

Pathways to Your Dream Degree

Applying for uni next year but worried that you won't meet the ATAR requirements for your dream degree? Most institutions offer pathway options for applicants who don't meet the standard entry criteria for their courses. Often, you'll be able to find a different avenue into the course you're aiming for.

If you don't get an offer into your chosen degree because you haven't met the required lowest selection rank, you could start an alternative undergraduate course with a lower entry rank. Once you've successfully completed the first year of that degree, and have results that will improve your selection rank, you can then apply again for the degree you really want.
