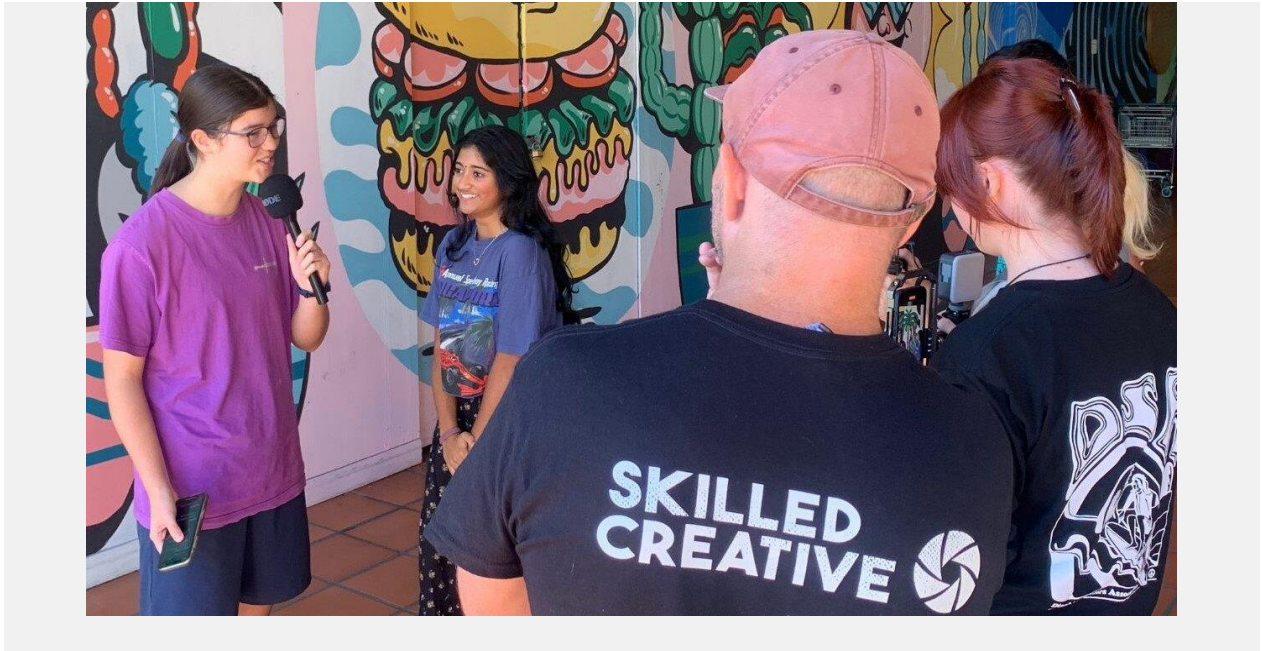

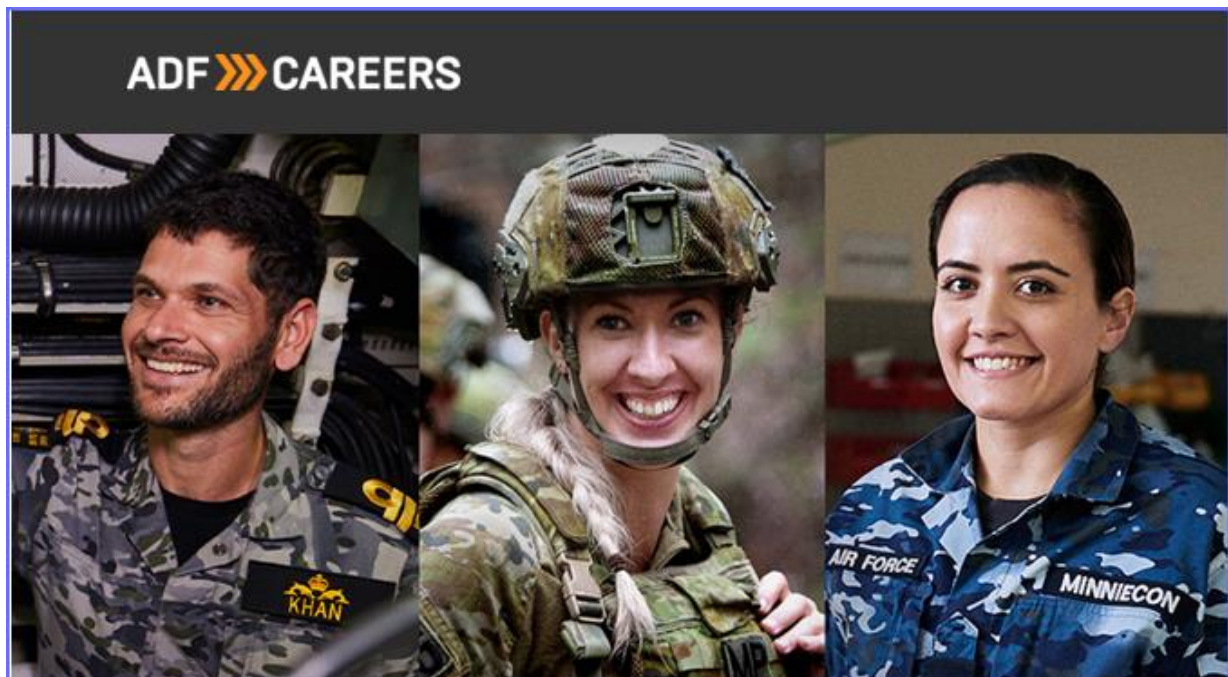

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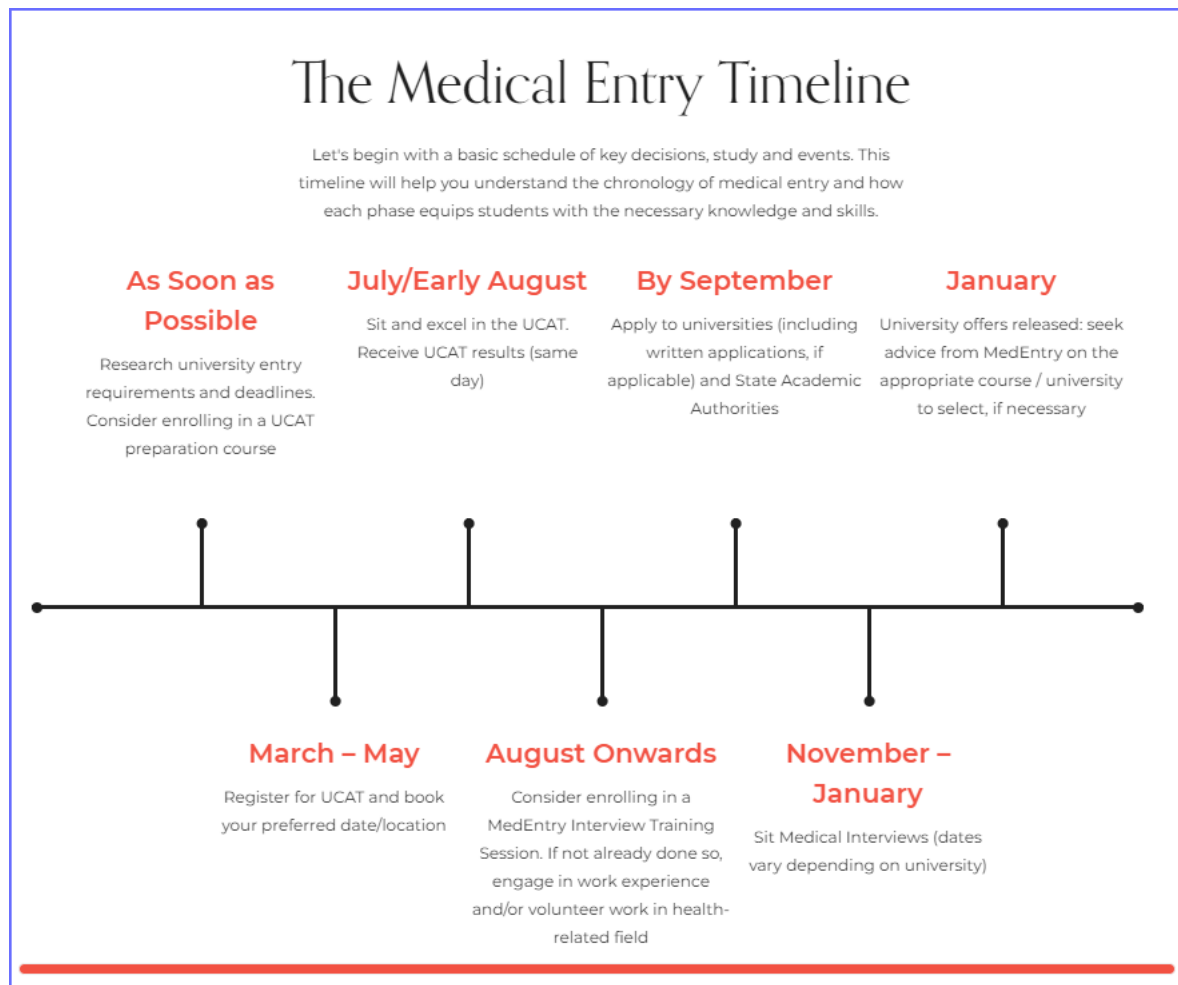

UAC - Schools Recommendation Schemes (SRS)

Upcoming Rounds:

- November Round 1 - Preference by 1 November
- November Round 2 - Preferences by 14 November
- December Round 1 - Preferences by 24 November

The Schools Recommendation Scheme (SRS) is one way institutions make early offers of undergraduate admission to Year 12 students. They do this by using criteria other than (or in addition to) the ATAR. Each institution has its own policy for determining SRS eligibility and making offers. For example, you may also have to submit an EAS application or attend a school in a particular region.

SRS is not available for all courses. The institution-specific SRS criteria detail any exceptions.

University of Sydney ARTiculate Drama - Giving shape to the world of a play: Getting started with set design

7 November

Theatre, above all, is a spatial artform. It's about defining the relationship and energy flow between audience and performer; it's putting ideas into space; it's finding a physical form to convey the emotional landscape of a play. In this webinar, we are delighted to host award-winning set and costume designer, Isabel Hudson, who will be in conversation with Dr Paul Dwyer from the Discipline of Theatre and Performance Studies. We'll look at a couple of Isabel's beautiful finished designs, analysing key steps in the process through which they were developed and how they support the overall vision of the play. Then we'll talk about perhaps the hardest part: how do you even begin? What should you be looking for on the first read of whatever play you select from the HSC Drama prescribed texts? How do you find those first few sparks of a concept/vision? How do you stretch and test your ideas with the goal of executing a design that's original, inventive, coherent and practical? While our focus is on set design, the underlying principles are, of course, also directly relevant to other HSC Drama Individual Projects in Design (e.g. costume and lighting) and Critical Analysis (e.g. director's folio and portfolio of theatre criticism).
