### Educational Access Scheme: deadline reminder

UAC's [Educational Access Scheme \(EAS\)](#) can help **undergraduate applicants** who have encountered significant educational challenges. You don't have to be a school leaver to apply for EAS; many institutions consider EAS applicants who have already undertaken tertiary study.

To have your EAS application assessed in time for December Round 2 (23 December 2024) offers, apply via your UAC undergraduate application and upload your documents by **21 November 2024**.

If you don't receive an SRS offer, don't worry: the main offer rounds for Year 12 students are December Round 2 (23 December) and January Round 1 (9 January), after ATARs are released. Your course preferences will be considered again in these offer rounds.

SRS offers can be unconditional or conditional.

The Narm Scholarship is offered to both domestic students who are enrolling an undergraduate degree and are experiencing disadvantaged circumstances, and Indigenous students who are enrolling in an undergraduate degree.

Disadvantaged circumstances include living in a low socio-economic area, receiving Commonwealth income support, having a disability or medical condition, or experiencing personal difficulties.

This scholarship provides the following benefits:

- A living allowance of \$6,500 per year for four years paid in half-yearly instalments of \$3250 in April and September
- A one-off relocation allowance of \$3,000 paid shortly after enrolling in their course for students from regional or remote areas of Australia
- An accommodation allowance of up to \$20,000 per year for four years paid directly to the accommodation provider for students from regional and remote areas of Australia who are living at approved University Student Accommodation.
