Once UCAT registrations open on 1 March, students who are planning to sit UCAT this year will need to complete the two-step registration process to secure their UCAT test date. Test allocations are available on a strictly first-come, first-served basis - in past years, popular dates were snatched up within 30 minutes of registrations opening - so students need to book as quickly as possible to get their ideal test date.

Before Booking your test:

If your students would like to apply for the lower concession fee, they need to do it <u>HERE</u> before booking your test. Applications are open NOW and close on 10 May 2023.

If your students would like to apply for extra time or other allowances on the basis of medical/other needs, they need to do it <u>HERE</u> before booking for the test. Applications are open NOW and close on 17 May 2023.



The UAC website has much information about applying for University and provides details about courses Universities offer.


The UAC website is where students apply for courses at most Universities in NSW.

Early entry does not mean you start University early... it means you can receive an offer for a University course earlier (e.g. in November) than most students receive their offers in the general round of offers (e.g. in December).

There is also information about the Educational Access Scheme (EAS) which is an opportunity for students who have been affected by long term disruption to their studies can apply for special consideration by the Universities.
