Applications are now open for the Macquarie Leaders and Achievers Early Entry Scheme! Current Year 12 students who have performed well academically in Year 11 and demonstrate leadership skills, personal development, and dedication through extracurricular activities, can apply for their dream degree through this scheme.

Your students could secure their dream degree early to allow them to focus and do their best on their final exams. <u>Hear how Sienna got into her dream degree early</u> – and how that helped her smash the HSC!

Students can list up to five courses in their application. Students will automatically be assed for The <u>Macquarie Leaders and Achievers Scholarship</u> valued at \$10,000 per year for up to 5 years for 20 outstanding applicants and/or the <u>Bachelor of Economics Grant</u> valued at \$2,500 for their first year of study for 10 outstanding applicants.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Students apply directly through the Macquarie Leaders and Achievers webpage
- We recommend that students use their personal email address and not a school address to create their application.
- Students cannot change their course preferences once they have submitted their application (unlike SRS through UAC). They should list their course preferences according to what they wish to study most.
- Students can only apply once and can only receive one outcome through this scheme. If a student has received an application outcome in the first round, they will not be considered for another outcome in the second round.
- To be considered in the first round, students must submit their application by 11:59pm on Monday, 31 July 2023 to receive an outcome on 4 September. Final applications close on 31 August to receive an outcome on 28 September 2023.



Introducing UNSW Portfolio Entry Early Conditional Offers

We are excited to announce that for Term 1, 2024 onwards, **domestic** students who are successful in applying for the **UNSW Portfolio Entry Scheme** will be eligible for an **Early Conditional Offer**.

Portfolio Entry provides students applying for most **Arts, Design & Architecture** and **Engineering** degrees with the opportunity to showcase their passion and talent through a portfolio of work, alongside their ATAR.

What is a Portfolio Entry Early Conditional Offer?

Successful applicants will receive an early conditional offer which has an adjusted ATAR requirement **up to 10 ATAR points below the lowest selection rank** for a specific degree or range of related degrees.

If a student meets or exceeds the adjusted ATAR requirement for an eligible degree and lists this as their highest eligible preference in UAC for the specified UAC offer round, then they will be issued a firm offer to that degree.

For Term 1, 2024 entry, firm offers for Portfolio Entry will be issued in UAC December Round 2 (NSW and ACT applicants) and January Round 1 (Interstate and IB applicants).

When is the Deadline?

Submissions for Term 1, 2024 are already open, with early conditional offers released **Friday, 1 September 2023**.

A late round of Portfolio Entry applications will open **Saturday**, **2 September 2023** and close on **Wednesday**, **22 November 2023**. Late round early conditional offers will be released on **Friday**, **8 December 2023**.

SCHOLARSHIPS

THE AVONDALE VICE CHANCELLOR / PRESIDENT'S SCHOLARSHIP

The Vice Chancellor / President's Scholarship is one of Avondale University's (Avondale's) most prestigious scholarships. It is awarded to students in their final year of selected secondary schools throughout Australia and New Zealand. This scholarship is reserved for students who show transformational qualities through their schooling years. Potential students for this scholarship may be nominated by their school or they may self-nominate with endorsement from their school. The scholarship is awarded to the student who best fulfills the scholarship criteria. This decision is made by the Avondale Scholarships and Prizes Committee, in consultation with the applicant's School Principal.

Applicants must demonstrate:

- A strong positive influence that changes the lives of others
- A significant contribution to school, community, family and/or church

DETAIL S

The Avondale Vice Chancellor / President's Scholarship is worth up to \$8,000 in total. It is worth \$3,000 in the first year of study (\$1,500 per semester) in an undergraduate degree or an Outdoor Leadership Vocational Education and Training (VET) course, \$2,000 (\$1,000 per semester) in the second year and \$1,500 per year (\$750 per semester) for the third and (where relevant) fourth year of a degree course. The scholarship is granted for a maximum of four years. Recipients receive a certificate and letter of congratulation.

CONDITIONS

- Direct entry into an undergraduate degree or Outdoor Leadership course, but does not include provisional entry and adjustment factors;
- 2 Normally only one Vice Chancellor / President's Scholarship will be presented per eligible school;
- 3 The scholarship is not transferable to any other student;
- 4 Prior to commencing enrolment at Avondale the scholarship can be deferred for up to one year. Recipients must notify Student Administration Services in writing if they wish to defer their scholarship.
- Once the recipient has commenced enrolment at Avondale the scholarship can be deferred for up to one year only. Recipients must have approved intermission and notify Student Administration Services in writing if they wish to defer their scholarship;
- 6 The recipient can only receive benefit from one Avondale funded scholarship per year;
- 7 The semester value of the scholarship can only be applied to the recipient's general fees account or tuition account after Census date and cannot be redeemed for cash, in part or in whole;
- 8 If payment of the full scholarship places the recipient's account in credit in the first year, the excess funds may be applied to the recipient's account in the second year;
- The recipient must undertake a full-time study load of at least 18 credit points (3 units) (or equivalent in an Outdoor Leadership VET course) per semester. The scholarship will be discontinued following the semester in which less than 18 credit points (3 units) (or equivalent in Outdoor Leadership VET course) are taken, however recipients may apply in writing to the Director, Student Administration Services, for special consideration if there is a case of extenuating circumstances. Any approved cross-institutional study will be included when determining a student's study load for each semester;
- 10 Continuance of the scholarship is contingent upon the recipient maintaining an academic status of 'Good Standing' by passing more than 50% of units in a semester;
- 11 The scholarship is granted for a maximum of four years and this needs to be taken into account where a recipient chooses to change course while enrolled at Avondale;
- 12 All offers are made subject to confirmation of academic status;
- All recipients should be of good standing in the community. Scholarships or part thereof may be revoked at the discretion of the Discipline Committee, where the recipient brings the name of Avondale into disrepute.




