UAC News

All courses available soon

All 2024 courses from UAC's participating institutions will be available on UAC's website in early August.

For students who have already applied, this is a good time for them to log in to their application and review and update their preferences.

For students who haven't yet applied, the early bird period ends on **Friday 29 September**, at which time the processing fee increases. Even if they're not sure what course they want to study, they should apply before then and put in any course as a placeholder until they are ready to decide.

UAC PIN reminder

In early August, an email will be sent to Year 12 students who haven't applied to remind them of their UAC PIN. PINs will be emailed to the address they have registered with NESA, so they need to ensure that this is a current email address.

To start their UAC application, students will need their NESA Year 12 student number or ACT BSSS number and their UAC PIN. Once they have applied, they use their UAC application number and UAC PIN to log in and manage their application.

If students don't have their UAC PIN email, or are having problems with their PIN, they can <u>read</u> the PIN FAOs or contact UAC.

How to apply through UAC

Early offers to Year 12 students

While the ATAR is still the main selection tool used by most unis, there are other ways for students to show that they're ready to succeed at tertiary study. This means they may be able to receive an offer to university before ATARs are released.

Early offers through UAC

The first UAC offers to Year 12 students will be made to <u>Schools Recommendation Scheme (SRS)</u> applicants on 10 November 2023. Offers made then are not based on HSC results and ATARs. Instead, they are based on criteria like Year 11 results and the school's rating of the student. In some cases, they will be conditional offers, which means that the student still has to meet other criteria, such as achieving a

specified minimum ATAR. To be eligible, you must be in Year 12 and have already applied through UAC for undergraduate admission in 2024. Applications for SRS close on Monday 18 September.

Early offers from institutions

In addition to submitting an SRS application, Year 12 students can apply directly to individual institutions for an early offer. Each institution has different application and offer dates. Our website has a list of institutions that have their own <u>early offer schemes</u>.

Everything Year 12s need to know about early offers.

Access and scholarship programs

Applications for the Schools Recommendation Scheme, Educational Access Scheme and Equity Scholarships are all open and <u>application guides are available to download</u>.

Educational Access Scheme (EAS)

Institutions acknowledge that difficult circumstances may prevent students from reaching their true academic potential. UAC's <u>Educational Access Scheme (EAS)</u> can help.

You don't have to be a school leaver to apply for EAS; many institutions give consideration to EAS applicants who have already undertaken tertiary study.

If you've already applied for EAS, don't forget to upload your supporting documentation. You can check what documents you need to supply by <u>logging in to your application</u>.

Equity Scholarships

<u>Equity Scholarships (ES)</u> help financially disadvantaged students with the costs associated with tertiary study. You can apply for an Equity Scholarship if you're applying to, or already enrolled at, a participating institution.







University of Sydney Articulate PDHPE: Health Equity in Australia Today
