He served as Minister for Finance and Small Business; and then as Minister for Finance and Minister for Employee Relations, in the last Liberal and Nationals Government. Prior to being elected to Parliament, Damien was a partner in the law firm O'Hara and Company, Solicitors.

From 2011 to 2015, Damien was the Chief of Staff to the then-Attorney General of New South Wales, The Hon. Greg Smith SC.

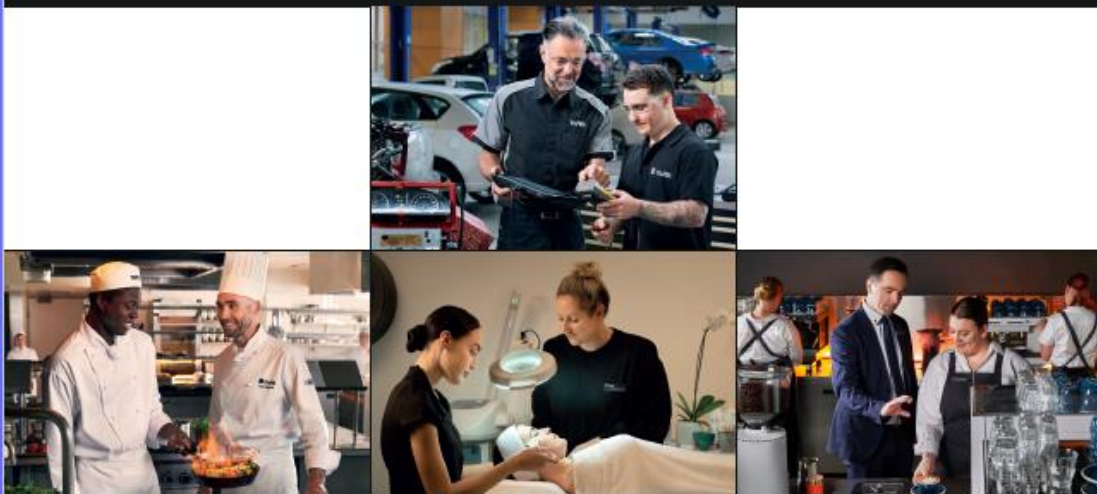

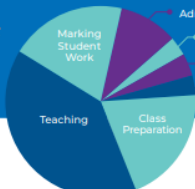

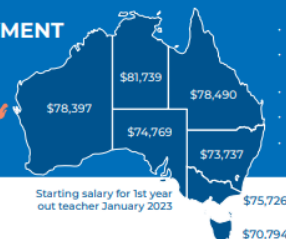
