#### All 2024 courses are now available

All 2024 courses are now available on UAC's course search.

If you've already applied, now is a good time to <u>log back in to your application</u> and review your preferences. You'll need your <u>application number and UAC PIN</u>.

If you haven't yet applied, do so as soon as you can. The early bird period ends on **Friday 29 September**, at which time the processing fee increases. Even if you're not sure what course you want to study, you should apply before then and put in any course as a placeholder until you are ready to decide.

## Access and scholarship programs...

A reminder that the <u>Educational Access Scheme (EAS)</u>, <u>Schools Recommendation Scheme (SRS)</u> and <u>Equity Scholarships</u> are all open for applications.

If you've already applied for EAS, don't forget your supporting documentation. Your EAS application won't be considered until UAC has received all of your paperwork. You can check what you need to supply on <u>UAC's website</u>.

#### Another reminder that SRS applications close on Monday 18 September.

To apply for EAS and SRS, you must submit the UAC application first.

## **Early offers to Year 12 students**

While the ATAR is still the main selection tool used by most unis, there are other ways for students to show that they're ready to succeed at tertiary study. This means they may be able to receive an offer to university before ATARs are released.

#### Early offers through UAC

The first UAC offers to Year 12 students will be made to <u>Schools Recommendation Scheme</u> (SRS) applicants on 10 November 2023. Offers made then are not based on HSC results and ATARs. Instead, they are based on criteria like Year 11 results and the school's rating of the student. In some cases, they will be conditional offers, which means that the student still has to meet other criteria, such as achieving a specified minimum ATAR. Applications for SRS close on Monday 18 September.

#### **Early offers from institutions**

In addition to submitting an SRS application, Year 12 students can apply directly to individual institutions for an early offer. Each institution has different application and offer dates. Our website has a list of institutions that have their own <u>early offer schemes</u>.

#### Tips for students:

- **1**. Students should diversify their preferences. We recommend choosing a range of degrees with varying entry requirements by using published selection ranks as a guide.
- **2.** Students should not include brand new activities or examples in their reflection that aren't previously described in their 2-3 example activities. The reflection should only focus on the activities already provided.
- **3.** Students need to be more detailed when indicating their tasks and responsibilities and not just supply a general role description.
- **4.** Referees for activities must be carefully chosen. We recommend placing a supervisor or leader that can confirm their involvement; and discourage placing parents (unless working in a family-owned business), friends or themselves as referees.

As always, activities provided must demonstrate leadership skills, personal development and dedication through extracurricular activities (see examples) and students need to double-check all parts of their application before submitting. No changes can be made afterwards.


