
Legacy Scholarship Program

2024 Legacy Scholarship Program







Are you the direct descendant (i.e. child, grandchild or even great-grandchild) of a veteran of the Australia Defence Force? If so, and:

- you reside on the Central Coast; and
- are under 25 years of age,

you may be eligible to apply for one of our scholarships.

Legacy offers scholarships for study at university, TAFE or approved private colleges as well as for apprenticeships, short or part-time VET courses and courses in the creative arts or sport. Legacy can also provide eligible high school students with financial assistance to help them complete Years 11 and 12.

Legacy scholarships range from up to \$3000 for a VET course to \$5000 for the first year of a university degree, increasing to \$6000 in year 3.

There are a range of teaching scholarships, internships and immersions to make your pathway to employment easier. Check with universities as to what's on offer.





Becoming a Teacher





Find out what skills and attributes you need to be a teacher, and whether this rewarding career is right for you.



UNIVERSITY

Bachelor of Education

This undergraduate course is a mix of educational theory, pedagogy (how to teach), subject content (e.g. Maths, History) and practical experience.

Approx. 4 years

Bachelor of Education + Bachelor of Arts/Science

This undergraduate course includes all of the above, but you go into more depth with the subject content.

Approx. 4 - 5 years

Master of Teaching

For those who already have a Bachelor Degree, this postgraduate course focuses on educational theory, pedagogy and practical experience.

Approx. 1 - 2 years

LANTITE

This is the Literacy and Numeracy Test for Initial Teacher Education. It was introduced to ensure all teachers are able cope with the literacy and numeracy demands of the profession.

You can take the online LANTITE in Year 11 or 12 - there are several opportunities to take the test. The LANTITE is very similar to NAPLAN or Minimum Standards, and there are practice questions so you can prepare.

The Australian Government has committed a further 300,000 fee-free Vocational Education and Training (VET) places to be delivered by states and territories between 2024 and 2026 inclusive.

Those leaving school, looking for work, or wanting to upskill and change careers, may be eligible for a range of study options, including a diploma, certificate, or short course.

Their greatly appreciated contributions allow up to 60% of our students to receive a scholarship to assist them with their regular College fees. Scholarships vary in amount from \$1,000 to \$5,000 per student and are allocated by an Independent Scholarship Selection Panel. The main selection criterion is financial need, but other important considerations include likely contribution to community, dedication to studies and intended career path.

A single Scholarship Application Form is available which applies to all scholarships generally. A small number of scholarships have specific selection criteria requested by the benefactor which is usually associated with the applicant's chosen field of work. Unless otherwise stated, applications for the above scholarships close at the end of November. Successful applicants are notified in December/January. A covering letter providing information on the financial position of the applicant and their family (including taxable income) is recommended.

How to Write Essays Worksop for Years 10, 11 and 12

22 - 23 January 2024

This two-day Essay Writing course focuses on the essay form and related critical thinking, language and punctuation skills for students in Years 10 – 12. The course is relevant to a range of subjects that require the writing of essays for assignments and exams. We will study how to structure essays, organise ideas and information, and write in appropriate language for assignments and exam essays. There will be an analysis of the essay form and the need for an organised, logical argument with evidence and analytic discussion of the evidence. This will include a focus on appropriate language, rhetoric and punctuation as well as study of the nature of a formal voice, appropriate educated vocabulary for different courses, and the range from a formal to a more conversational voice. Sophisticated punctuation is introduced as a mode of complex thinking. The sections on the body of the essay focus on critical thinking and argument as a combination of a sequence of ideas, evidence and extended analytic comment about evidence.
