Do you want to study medicine or dentistry in 2025? If so, you will need to sit UCAT 2024. This blog describes everything you need to know about UCAT 2024.

What is UCAT?


UCAT stands for University Clinical Aptitude Test. The UCAT is a 2-hour long computer-based exam that is required to gain entry into most medicine and dentistry courses across Australia, New Zealand and the UK.

Each university varies in how it uses UCAT scores, but most use UCAT scores to select students for interview and for final offers of a medicine or dentistry place.



Early Entry Applications for University

Early entry does not mean that you start University early... it means that you can receive and offer for a University course before the general offers come out.

Universities have various programs of their own to provide early offers to applicants for University places.



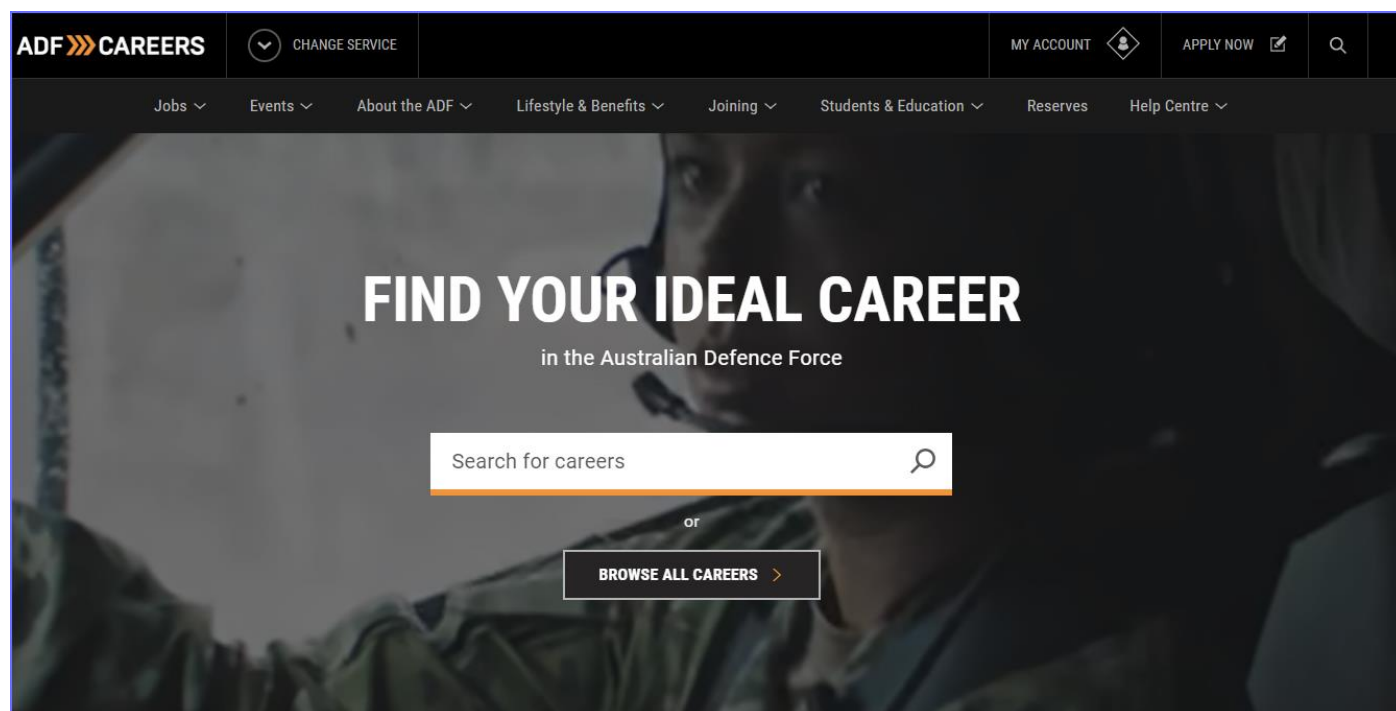
Early offer schemes for Year 12 students

Many institutions have one or more early offer schemes for Year 12 students. Through these schemes, the institutions will assess you using criteria other than (or in addition to) your ATAR. Always check the institution websites to make sure the courses you are applying for are covered by the schemes.
