KINDERGARTEN TO YEAR 12

Green Point Christian College encourages all students to wear its uniform with pride. The College uniform fosters an undertaking to the ethos and values of the College as it demonstrates a commitment to our community. Students wearing the College uniform reflect respect for the College, the staff and themselves.

The responsibility of wearing the uniform properly does not end at the College gates and it is important that the Green Point Christian College uniform is worn correctly when representing the College on excursions and when traveling to and from school.

Hems on all girls' uniforms K - 12 should modest, set to no more than 2cm above the knee when kneeling. All items of uniform should be clean, neat and have names labelled clearly.

Boys' shirts in Primary School are to be worn tucked in at all times.

There is no requirement to wear a hat to and from school, but a hat (bucket hat or sports cap) must be worn while at school in the playground during the months September to May. The College has a "no hat, no play" policy.

Boys – Winter alternatives

All items for the Primary Boys winter uniform remain the same with the alternative of wearing grey long pants when the weather is cold.

Shirt	Red/grey checked short sleeve shirt with logo stitched on pocket.
Pants	Long pants – school grey – NOT corduroy.
Jacket	Black soft shell College jacket and/or red wool blend jumper with embroidered logo.
Boys – Sport	
Shorts	Unisex black shorts with red logo.
Shirt	Red and white cotton backed polo shirt with school logo.
Socks	White sport socks – no stripes.
Hat	GPCC hat: Choice of sports cap or bucket hat.
Shoes	An appropriate lace up sports shoe which provides supported protection for the feet. This does not include canvas shoes, flat sole shoes, skate shoes or basketball boots.
Track Pants	Black microfiber/tropical fleece track pants (winter) with red logo.
Jacket	Black and red unisex College sports jacket.

Boys are not to wear any jewellery except a watch (no earrings are to be worn). Students wearing a smart watch must have the interactivity disabled or locked during school hours. Students found using their smart watch for matters other than telling the time will have it confiscated.

PRIMARY SCHOOL - KINDERGARTEN TO YEAR 6 - GIRLS

Girls - Summer

Dress or Skort	Grey checked dropped waist dress with white collar and red tab, or white tailored shirt with red and black and white stripped skort (no tab required).
Jacket	Black soft shell College jacket and/or red wool blend jumper with embroidered logo.
Hat	GPCC hat: College bucket hat or sports cap.
Socks	Short white anklet socks to be worn above the ankle (not tennis socks worn below the ankle).
Shoes	Black low profile polishable leather shoes, fully enclosed and protecting the foot or black buckle up Lady Jane style leather school shoe.
Bag	Black school bag with logo.
Hair	Shoulder length hair must be fully tied back. Hair accessories should be simple such as hair elastics, bobby pins or ribbons and should be red, black or white in colour. Hair must be of a neat and tidy appearance and should not draw attention to themselves in colour, cut or style.

- One fine chain (under blouse not visible).
- One silver or gold ring.
- Discreet cosmetics (natural skin tones).
- No bracelets.

Jewellery

Cardigan	Black cardigan with logo – optional.
Blazer	1st layer of warmth – black girls' blazer – compulsory in Terms 2 and 3.
Jumper	2nd layer of warmth – red wool blend jumper with embroidered logo.
Hat	GPCC hat: Choice of dress hat, bucket hat or sports cap.
Socks or	Short white anklet socks to be worn above the ankle.
Stockings	Black opaque stockings (70+Denier). Stockings must be worn for formal occasions.
Shoes	Hand polishable black lace up shoes with a hard sole and a small heel. Fully enclosed and protecting the foot.
Bag	Black school bag with logo. No other bag is to be used, even during examinations.
Hair	Students are allowed to have their hair out, but it must be pulled back from the face. Hair must be of a neat and tidy appearance and should not draw attention to themselves in colour, cut or style. Hair accessories should be simple such as hair elastics, bobby pins or ribbons and should be red, black or white in colour.

Shirt	White short sleeve shirt (no logo) – to be worn tucked in.
Pants	Long pants – Taupe logo trousers (as supplied by Uniform Shop only) with leather belt.
Belt	Supplied with trousers.
Blazer	1st layer of warmth – black boys blazer – compulsory in Terms 2 and 3.
Jumper	2nd layer of warmth – red wool blend jumper with embroidered logo.
Hat	GPCC hat: Choice of dress hat, bucket hat or sports cap.
Tie	Compulsory black tie with crest.
Socks	Short black socks.
Shoes	Hand polishable black lace up shoes with a hard sole and a small heel. Fully enclosed and protecting the foot.
Bag	Black school bag with logo. No other bag is to be used, even during examinations.
Hair	Long hair must be tied back. Hair must be of a neat and tidy appearance and should not draw attention to themselves in colour, cut or style. Boys must be clean-shaven during school terms.
